The Background & Context

Covid-19 Compliance Officer training is a compliance-course as directed and directly linked to the OHS Act. Government regulations addressing COVID-19 infections in the workplace requires that every workplace appoint a COVID-19 Compliance Officer (CCO).

The Compliance Officer must oversee the implementation of the COVID-19 HIRA workplace plan, ensure adherence to workplace measures put in place to manage the risk of COVID-19 infections, and communicate important information to workers and address their concerns.

It is essential that the COVID-19 Compliance Officer understand the importance of the role they are expected to fulfil and is equipped to implement the HIRA plan.

Health & Safety In The Workplace Gazette No. 43400 compels every employer by virtue of this directive to:

- Comply with their [OHS Act Section 8] and GG 43400 duties
- Consult with the OHS committee and redefine their roles
- Establish a COVID-19 OHS committee if necessary*
- Conduct the Clause 17 Risk Assessment.
- [Use a contractor if skills do not exist]
- Formulate and implement the HIRA (Risk Assessment) Plan
- Regularly test the Risk Assessment Plan and emergency procedures
- Appoint, empower and authorize a Covid-19 Compliance Officer (CCO), in writing.
- Issue visible identification to the CCO.
- Talk to and evaluate the CCO by means of scheduled meetings.
- Promote COVID-19 OHS Awareness [OHS Act Section 19].
- Publish the identity and authority of the CCO.
