

Course Content & Outcomes

Learners will be upskilled in emergency care eg:

- Preparedness for health emergencies in the workplace.
- Environmental illness and injuries.
- Assessing and managing an emergency scene.
- The primary & secondary survey.
- Emergency life support for adults, children and infants, including single and two persons CPR, artificial respiration, using an AED and managing a choking patient.
- Bleeding and shock; anaphylactic shock
- Diabetes, epilepsy, asthma, stroke, heart attack.
- Management of wounds; soft tissue injuries.
- Common injuries, burns, poisoning etc.
- Head and spinal injuries, fractures, joint injuries etc
- Recording an incident/accident.

First aid and follow-up treatment.

Background & Context

The level 2 first aid course is focused on providing primary first aid care in the workplace in response to health emergencies, particularly those arising from an occupational risk in the specific workplace. First aid level 2 is a prerequisite for doing the advanced first aid level 3 course. This training course incorporates the specific outcomes and assessment criteria of the SAQA-registered Unit Standard 120496. CPR in this course complies with the guidelines released by the American Heart Association, October 2015. COVID-19 protocols as directed are covered in this course.
